A shocking incident has come to light, where a 26-year-old IAS aspirant has lost his life due to electrocution in Patel Nagar area. A young precious life has been lost due to the negligence and apathy of government officials. The cause of death needs to be ascertained and responsibility needs to be fixed in order to give a clear message that such instances will not be tolerated.

The Chief Secretary is directed to:

- 1. Initiate an inquiry into the matter and suggest action that should be taken against those who are responsible for this tragic loss. A report on the same to be sent to the office of undersigned by Friday 26th July, 5 pm.
- 2. Suggest policy measures so that such instances do not occur in the future.
- 3. No amount can compensate for the loss of life, but we hope to provide some relief to the grieving family members. A proposal for ex-gratia relief as per guidelines should also be put up by tomorrow 25th July, 5pm.
